

Walter Earle 4-H Scholarship

The Walter Earle 4-H Scholarship will be awarded to a Senior 4-H'er (ages 14-18), who exemplifies dedication, work ethic, sportsmanship, teamwork and commitment to livestock.

Regulations:

1. Awarded to Wilson County Senior 4-H'ers (ages 14-18 as of January 1).
2. There is no application for this award. A committee will be appointed to award this scholarship to a deserving individual. Selection will be based on work ethic, dedication to livestock projects, eagerness to learn, sportsmanship, teamwork, and involvement in the livestock industry.
3. 4-H'ers must be enrolled in a 4-H livestock project to be eligible.
4. It is not necessary to attend a four year college or university to be eligible, but this scholarship must be used for post-secondary education (i.e., certificate, technical school, community college, trade school, etc.)
5. An individual may win this award more than once.
