

What is 4-H?

4-H is the largest youth organization in the United States with more than 7 million participants. 4-H is best identified by its green four-leaf clover with an H on each leaf. The four H's on the emblem stand for Head, Heart, Hands, and Health. 4-H is the only youth organization based at land-grant universities and the first experience many youth have with higher education. Wilson County 4-H is a youth-driven organization that aims to teach youth within the county life skills. We want to assist youth and adults in Wilson County in becoming competent, coping, and contributing members of their society.

Wilson County 4-H Summer Fun Policies

- Be sure to check age requirements, times, and prices as you review activities in which to enroll your child. All camps will meet at the Wilson County Agricultural Center. Waiting lists will be available after camps fill up. Camp fees are **not refundable.** Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate.
- Each child must be enrolled in **4-HOnline2.0.** Adults picking up children **MUST** be listed (and will be asked to show a photo ID). Medicines will be provided as listed. The 4-H Code of Conduct must be signed and followed.
- Please keep track of which camps your child has signed up for. If he/she cannot make the camp,
 please let a 4-H staff member know at least 24 hours in advance before the camp occurs. We have
 waiting lists and would like to offer that space to another child. We make attempts to send
 reminders emails/texts about camps, but do not solely rely on these to make sure your child is
 present.
- The start and end times for these events are to be strictly enforced. Please do not drop off your child more than 15 minutes prior to the camp starting and pick them up no more than 15 minutes past the end time.
- Payments MUST be paid in FULL within three days of registration. Payments can be made at the Agricultural Center Tuesdays and Thursday 2:30-4:30 PM. If you are on the waiting list and get a call saying a space has opened, you must present payment when arriving for camp.
- Due to NC law, 4-H staff is not allowed to apply or supply **sunscreen or insect repellent** to your child. If the camp is taking place outside, please be sure to supply your child sunscreen/insect repellent and teach him/her how to properly apply it.
- Also due to NC law, 4-H staff are not allowed to supply or install **car seats.** If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place in the 4-H van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
- Wilson County Extension and 4-H are not responsible for any damaged, lost or stolen items. Bringing **cell phones** and other electronic devices is highly discouraged, if the device proves to be a distraction it will be confiscated and given back at the end of the day. We will keep a lost and found box if something is left behind. Call or email to pick it up.
