- 1 Exhibitors must be under 19 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
2. Entries must be completed no later than September 15, 2023. Entries must be completed using Showman. Contact show management if you have questions.
3. Decisions of the judge are final.
4. All hogs must meet North Carolina health requirements.
5. Hogs must be barrows or gilts of any breed or crossbred.
6. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries.
7. Weight cards will be used and must be turned in by 5pm on day of the show. Scales will be available up to 15 minutes before the show if needed and for judge to use for weigh backs. Market hogs are allowed a 10 pound difference.
8. Hogs will be judged as market animals.
9. Entries will be divided in classes at the discretion of the show committee.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their animals.
11. There will be no sale.
12. Exhibitors and/or their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting or participating in fraud or deception or acting in an unsportsmanship like manner, shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competitions.
13. The superintendent reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.
14. Any disputes or questions are to be directed to the show superintendent.
15. Any questions not covered by the rules will be ruled upon by the show superintendent.

4. All kids must meet North Carolina health requirements.
5. All horn tips must be dulled and/or blunt.
6. Kids can be wethers or does. (No bucks)
7. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries.
8. Kids must have all temporary (milk) teeth in place at the time of the show.
9. Weight cards will be used and must be turned in by 5pm on day of the show. Scales will be available up to 15 minutes before the show if needed and for judge to use for weigh backs. Market goats are allowed a 7 pound difference.
10. Kids must be dry at weighing.
11. Entries will be divided into classes at the discretion of the show committee.
12. Kids are released after the competition of the entire show.
13. Exhibitors and/or their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting or participating in fraud or deception or acting in an unsportsmanship like manner, shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competitions.
14. The superintendent reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.

RULES

1. Exhibitor must be under 19 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
2. Entries must be completed no later than September 15, 2023. Entries must be completed using Showman. Contact show management if you have questions.
3. Decisions of the judge are final.
4. All lambs must meet North Carolina health requirements.
5. Lambs can be wethers or ewes. (No rams)
6. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries.
7. Lambs must have all temporary (milk) teeth in place at the time of the show.
8. Weight cards will be used and must be turned in by 5pm on day of the show. Scales will be available up to 15 minutes before the show if needed and for judge to use for weigh backs. Market lambs are allowed a 7 pound difference.
9. Lambs must be dry at weighing.
10. Entries will be divided into classes at the discretion of the show committee.
11. Lambs are released after the competition of the entire show.
12. Exhibitors and/or their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting or participating in fraud or deception or acting in an unsportsmanship like manner shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competitions.
13. The superintendent reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.
14. Any disputes or questions are to be directed to the show superintendent.

15. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their animals while at the fair.  
16. Any questions not covered by these rules will be ruled upon by the show superintendent.

**17. Animals used in showmanship must be entered in the Wilson Fair in the name of a single showmanship exhibitor. This will be enforced.**

18. 17. Showmanship Divisions will be held at the beginning of the show in the order of Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior.

7. Exhibitors and/or their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting or participating in fraud or deception or acting in an unsportsmanship like manner, shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competitions.
8. The superintendent reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.
9. Any disputes or questions are to be directed to the show superintendent.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their animals while at the fair.
11. Any questions not covered by these rules will be ruled upon by the show superintendent.
12. Heifers eligible to show must be born after September 1, 2021.
13. Heifers must be halter broken. Unruly animals which endanger the safety of others will be asked to leave the ring.
14. If there are sufficient entries, breeds may be divided into British, Exotic, and Commercial divisions.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES  
September 15, 2023

RULES

1. Exhibitor must be under 19 years of age as of January 1, 2023.
2. All online or paper copy entry forms must be filed with the show management no later than September 15, 2023. Entry form must be completely filled out. Management will contact you if information is not included.
3. Decisions of the judge are final.
4. All steers must meet North Carolina health requirements.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries.
6. Steers are released after the completion of the entire show.
7. Eligible steers must be born after September 1, 2021.
8. Weight cards will be used and must be turned in by 11am on day of the show. Scales will be available up to 15 minutes before the show if needed and for judge to use for weigh backs. Steers are allowed a 50 pound difference.
9. Entries will be divided into classes at the discretion of the show committee by weight.
10. Exhibitors and/or their immediate family members found cheating, misrepresenting or participating in fraud or deception or acting in an unsportsmanship like manner, shall be disqualified and possibly barred from future competition.
11. The superintendent reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry which is late entering the show ring.
12. Any disputes or questions are to be directed to the show superintendent.
13. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their animals while at the fair.
14. Any question not covered by these rules will be ruled upon by the show superintendent.
15. Steers must be halter broken. Unruly animals which endanger the safety of others will be

asked to leave the ring.

16. There will be limited tie-outs in the cattle barn which you must strip before leaving. We highly suggest bringing a generator to tie-out at your at your trailer if possible.

**\*17. Animals used in showmanship must be entered in the Wilson Fair in the name of a single showmanship exhibitor. This will be enforced.**

18. Fitting is NOT required.

19. Heifers will show first by date of birth, followed with steers by weight, then cattle showmanship in the order of Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior.

Money awarded in classes will be based upon the number of entries.
